REQUIRED SUBMISSIONS FOR BUILDING PERMIT

1. Zoning Permit form

Fill out and attach 2 copies of the site plan. The site plan should show where the property lines, building setback lines, existing building(s) and driveway and proposed building(s), addition(s) and/or driveway(s). Locate the existing and proposed structures and driveway(s) with dimensions to the property lines. As an aid, many people use graph paper with a scale such as 1 square = 10 feet for example.

2. Application for Plan Examination and Building Permit

Either the Owner, or the General Contractor who is building the building or addition, may fill out *either one form or the other one listed below*. The Township is currently enforcing the PA Uniform Construction Code: 2006 International Residential Code, 2006 International Building Code, and all included codes including but not limited to Electrical, Energy, Existing Building, Fire, Mechanical and Plumbing.

Part 1: Fill out. The property address is the one in the Township. If you do not have a property address, one will be assigned as part of the building permit review process.

Part 2: Fill out. Sub-part B: You may check more than one box.

Part 3: Fill out.

Part 4: Fill out. "Signature of Applicant" line: Owners or Applicant, please sign, date & provide your address. "Responsible Person in Charge of Work & Title" line: Owner or Contractors, please list the person to whom the Certified Building Official may ask questions about the plans.

Form: International Code Council, 4 Page, ICC# 0003AP4F

Part I: Fill out. The property address is the one in the Township. If you do not have a property address, one will be assigned as part of the building permit review process. *Write your tax parcel number in the upper right hand corner of the top page; it will be in the format 68-xx-xx.x.*

Part II: Fill out. Sub-part A: You may check more than one box . Sub-part C: Put a zero (0) if there is no work in a specialty.

Part III: Fill out. Sub-part E: You may check more than one box. You may use the Notes and Data sub-part to further describe any part of the work, e.g. you will be re-connecting to the existing water well.

Part IV: Fill out. "Signature of Applicant" line: 1. Owners, please sign, print your name and date. 2. General Contractors, please have the *responsible person in charge of the work* sign, print name and date. Include in addition to your telephone number, your fax, cell phone or pager number, as appropriate, in the above Contractor sub-part.

Parts V, VI, VII and VII: Ignore.

Part IX: You may use this for the site plan. Refer to instructions for Zoning Permit above.

3. Workers' Compensation Insurance Form -

This form is only required if your General Contractor will be applying for and paying for the permit. Your General Contractor should fill out this form. A notarization is only necessary if your General Contractor is claiming exemptions under Part III. A copy of the certificate of insurance must be attached, with "West Nottingham Township" listed in the certificate holder section.

4. Road Occupancy Permit -

Fill out and submit if a new driveway entrance to a Township road is requested. If a new driveway entrance to a State road is requested, contact the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (PennDOT) to request their permit form for submission to PennDOT and the Township.

Checklist for Building Permit Applications: (Note: Delays in application review will occur if the application is not complete.)
Zoning Permit with two (2) copies of site plan.
Construction plans showing the foundation plan, roof plan, floor plan(s), typical wall sections, construction details, & bill of materials/specifications. Residential: Two (2) sets of plans. Commercial/Industrial: Three (3) sets of plans sealed by a PA registered Architect or Engineer.
Application for Plan Examination & Building Permit.
Workers' Compensation Insurance Form.
Additional permit copies as required:
Chester County Heath Department water well & sewage disposal system permits.
* For new construction: Chester County Health Department - Water well & Sewage Disposal System permits with "approved to construct" signature and date.
* For residential additions & mobile home replacements, contact the County Health Department and submit either review letters or a copy of any new permits.

PennDOT road occupancy permits, with "approved signature" and date.
